

The human royal council was the social model for ancient ideas about divine knowledge being secret, just as human kings had secrets, so too did the gods. Diviners who received this knowledge from the gods in an on-going ad hoc manner were an essential link between the divine assembly and the human royal council for whom such knowledge was intended. Scribes eventually adapted the ad hoc divinatory means of receiving divine communications to their culturally significant texts. By discursively asserting a historical
