



Sickle cell anemia, hemophilia, Cooley's anemia, and Tay Sachs disease have been among the front runners for support. Finally, in 1975 Congress has begun to examine an omnibus bill concerning all forms of genetic disease. The bill, termed the National Genetic Diseases Act, is however still far from being enacted.

It was to nurture cooperation and understanding that we brought together a distinguished faculty of internationally known experts on law and genetics to discuss their fields in 1975.
